Please consult a health care professional if your baby present any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (+ de 37,5°C/ 99,5°F)
- Irritability, acute crying
- Lethargy
- Difficulty waking up
- Poor muscle tone
- Trouble breathing or fast breathing
- Loss of appetite
- Yellowish skin
- Blood in stools
- Weight loss
- Projectile vomiting
- Stools are hard and dry
- Urine is dark and strong smelling
- Insufficient number of wet diapers
- Umbilical cord stump area is red, swollen, oozing or smells bad
- Involuntary rhythmic movements of the body, arms or legs
