How to collect a urine sample threw my indwelling catheter



- 1. At home, before coming to the hospital, clamp urine catheter tubing at least 8 cm (3 inches) below needleless sampling port.
- 2. Leave clamp in place for 15 minutes or until an adequate amount of urine collects in tubing.
- · For urine culture, 3-5 mL of urine is sufficient.
- · 10-20 mL is needed for urinalysis



- 3. Wash your hands.
- 4. Vigorously scrub needleless sampling port with an antiseptic wipe, included in your kit, for at least 15 seconds and let dry.



- 5. Remove syringe, included in your kit, from sterile packaging and connect tip of syringe directly to needleless sampling port.
- 6. Slowly pull back syringe plunger to withdraw urine and obtain adequate amount of urine based on lab volume requirements.



- 7. Inject collected urine into sterile specimen container without contaminating specimen.
- 8. Secure lid on specimen container.
- 9. Unclamp tubing clamp from your urine catheter.
- 10. Confirm catheter tubing does not have kinks, and urine is flowing freely via gravity into collection bag.
- 11. Place specimen in a biohazard bag, wash your hands and hand over to the lab technician.



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
